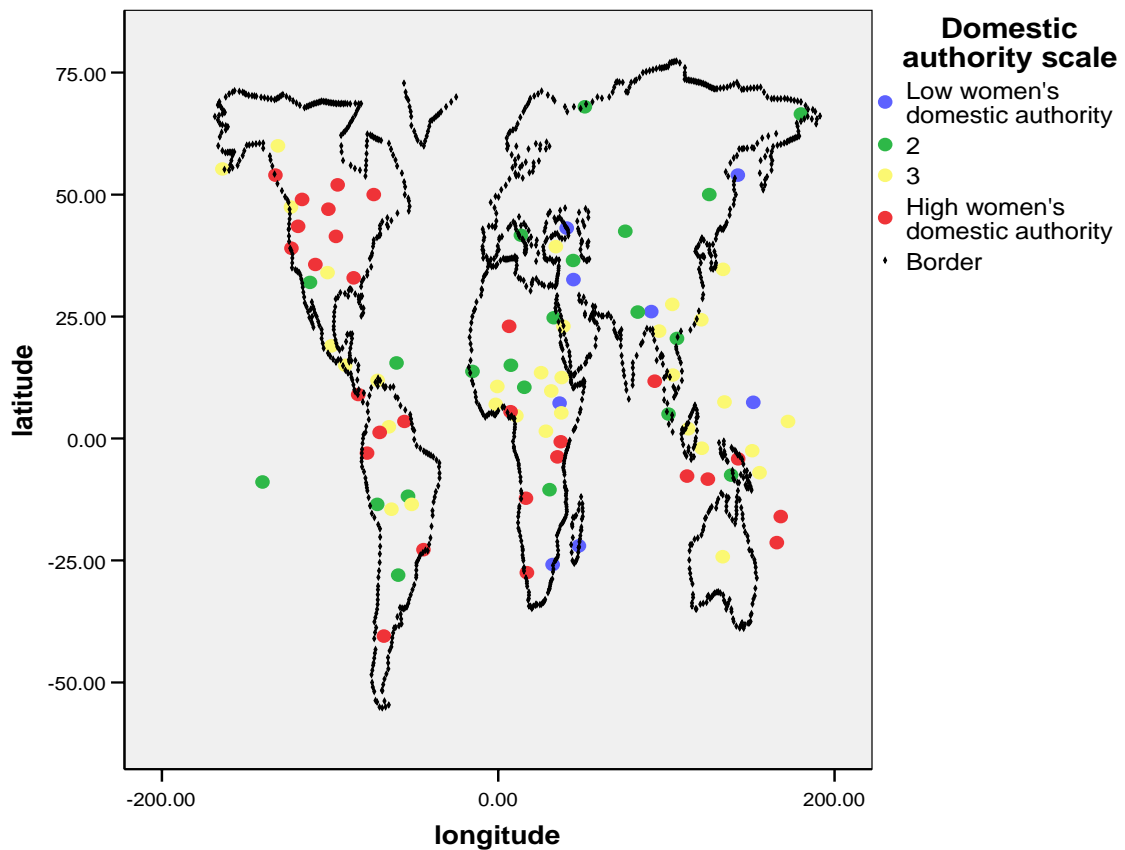
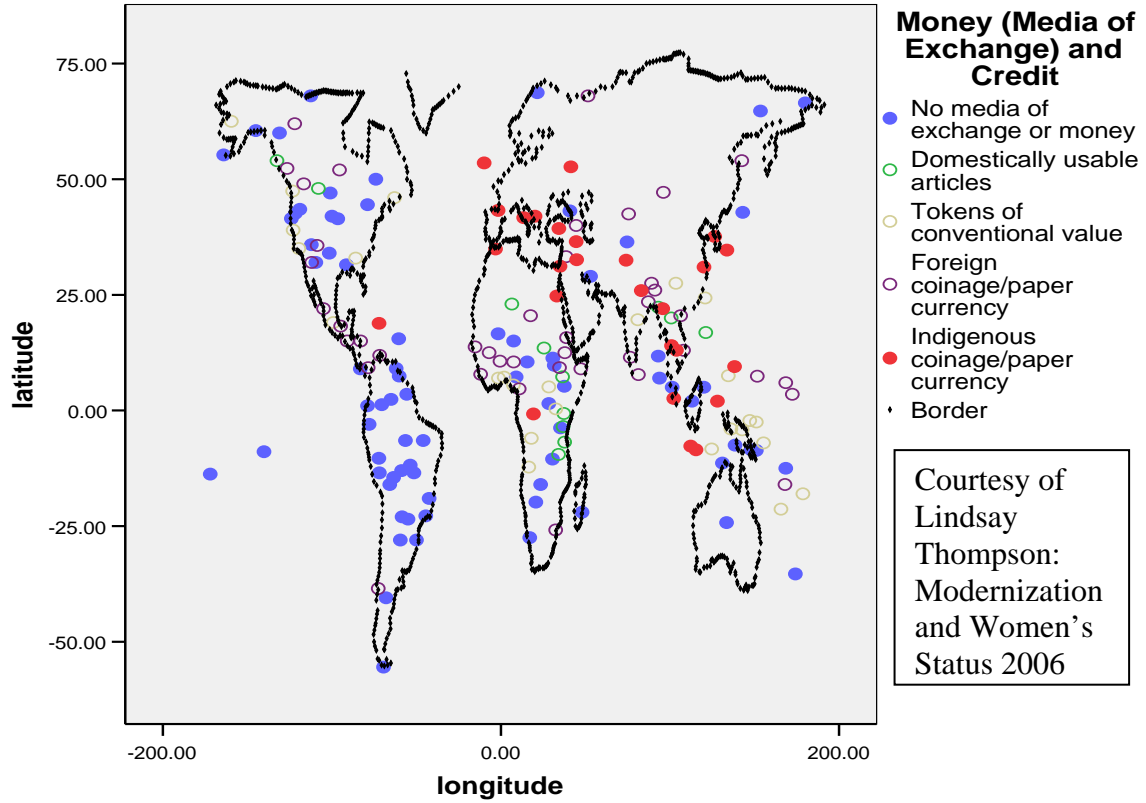

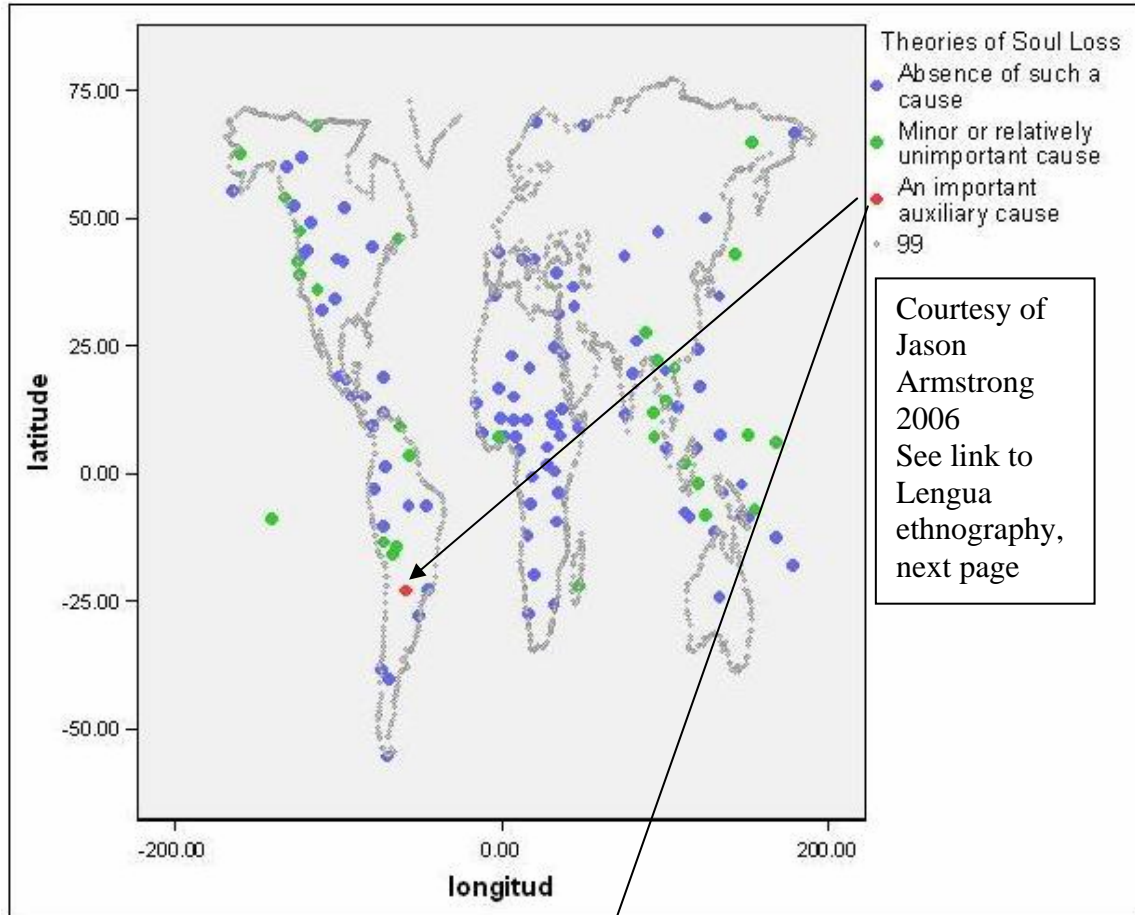


Figure 5. Distribution of v.653 Theories of Soul Loss

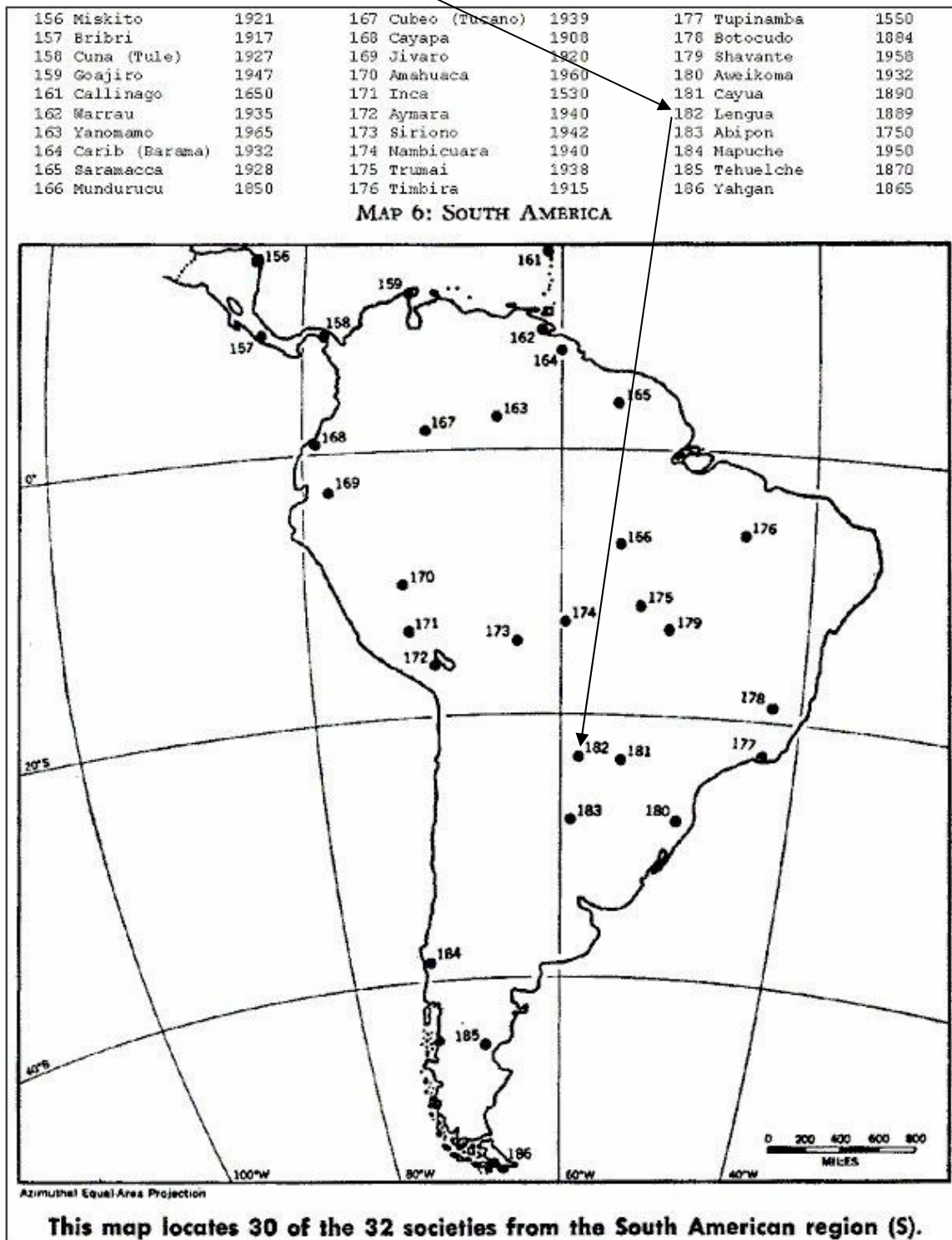
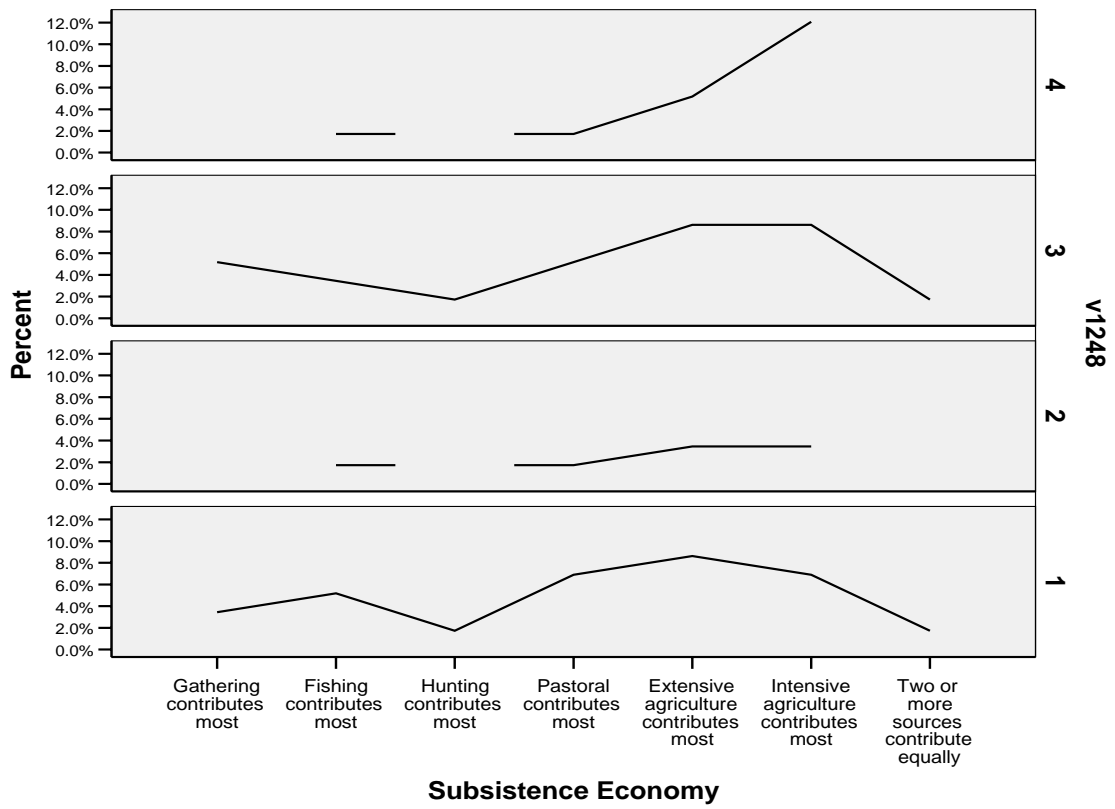
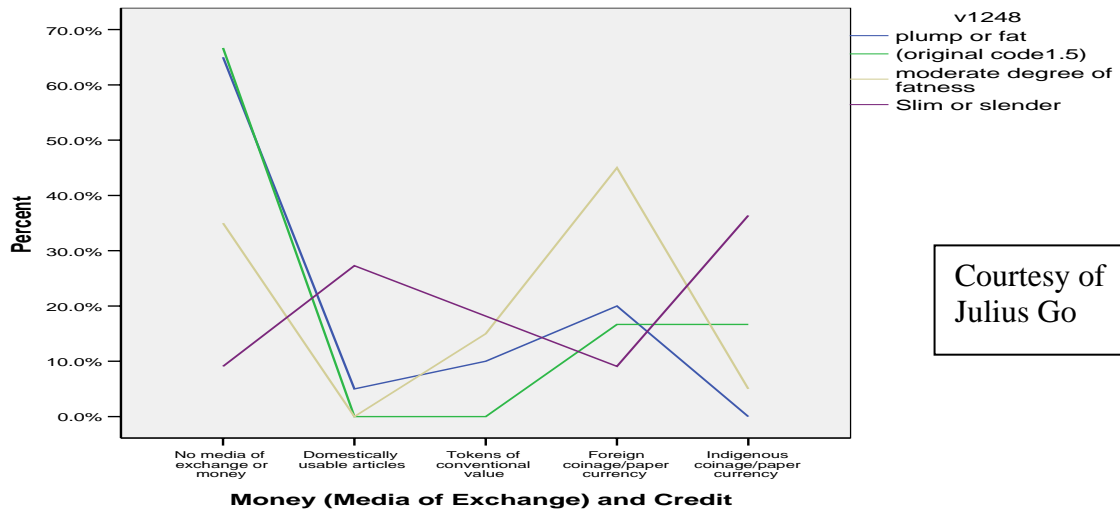
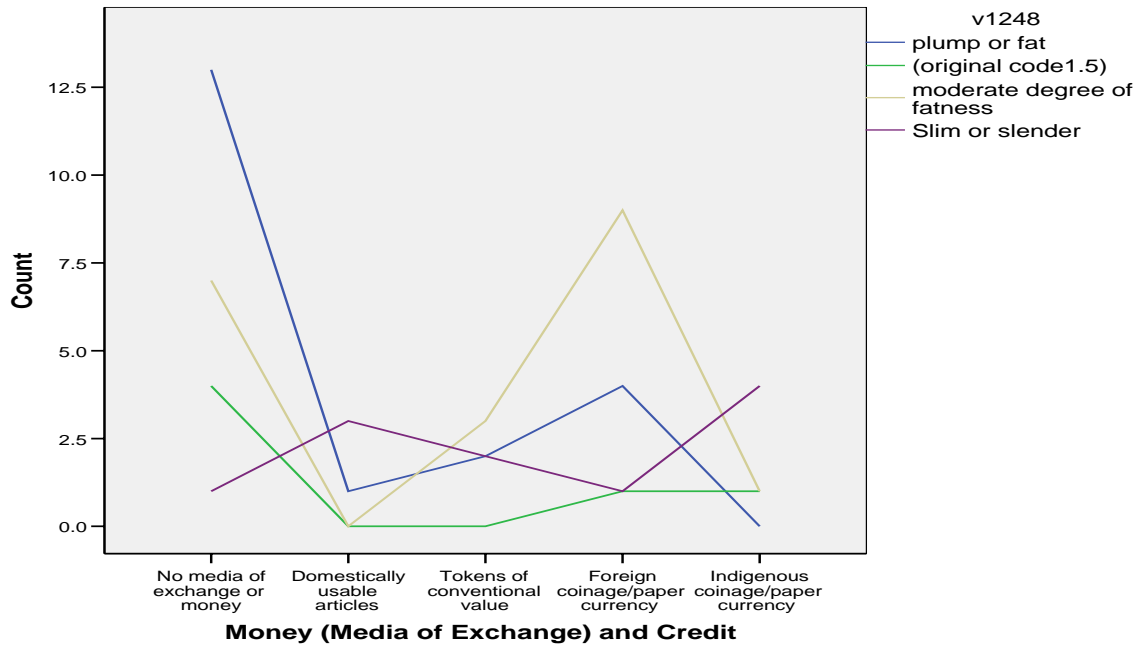


Figure 6. SMSS map of South America
