

There's a typo in the statement on page 132 in the definition of $B\uparrow$ and $F\downarrow$: The A should be replaced by B . Similarly, in the second equation, E should be F , corrected thus:

$$B\uparrow = \{e \text{ in } E \mid (a, e) \text{ in } I \text{ for all } a \text{ in } B\}.$$

$$F\downarrow = \{a \text{ in } A \mid (a, e) \text{ in } I \text{ for all } e \text{ in } F\}.$$
